

McHAPPY DAY AT PAYWORKS



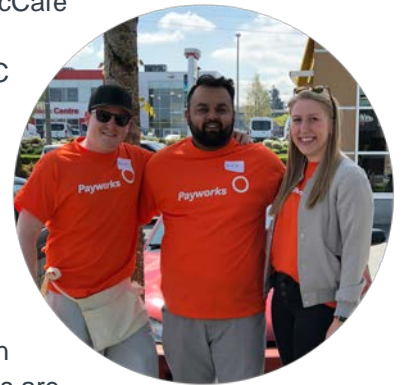
Keeping families close
