

# McHAPPY DAY AT PAYWORKS



May 10, 2019 – On May 8, 2019, Payworks employees across Canada showed their support for **McHappy Day®** and **Ronald McDonald House Charities® (RMHC) Canada** by putting on a big smile, working behind the counter and participating in other activities in 12 McDonald's Restaurants from coast to coast, including locations in Victoria, Winnipeg, Toronto, Niagara Falls, St-Laurent, and Bridgewater.

On McHappy Day, McDonald's donates \$1.00 from every Big Mac®, Happy Meal, and hot McCafé beverage sold all day to local RMHC and to various other local children's charities across Canada. Since launching in 1977, McHappy Day has raised more than \$67 million for RMHC and local children's charities. Payworks employees have volunteered at McHappy Day events across Canada since 2014.

"Our team was stationed outside at the drive-thru and inside the restaurant collecting donations, and we collected hundreds of dollars and had so much fun! In May 2015, Payworks announced its official national partnership with Ronald McDonald House Charities Canada. RMHC Canada was founded in 1982 to be the everlasting organization that would support Ronald McDonald Houses and their programs in Canada. The 15 Ronald McDonald Houses provide a home away from home for out-of-town families with sick children being treated at a nearby hospital, while the 16 Ronald McDonald Family Rooms provide a caring place for families to rest and recharge, right beside the hospital. Today, the Ronald McDonald Houses and Ronald McDonald Family Rooms support over 26,000 families from over 1,800 communities across Canada each year.

Angela Peskett, Payworks Sales Administrator, volunteered in Victoria, British Columbia. "I was at the window handing out food to the customers and one couple were grandparents of a little girl who is in Ronald McDonald House BC right now. What an impact that had on me. This couple had no idea it was McHappy Day, but they were very happy that they went through the drive thru for lunch and gladly made a donation."
